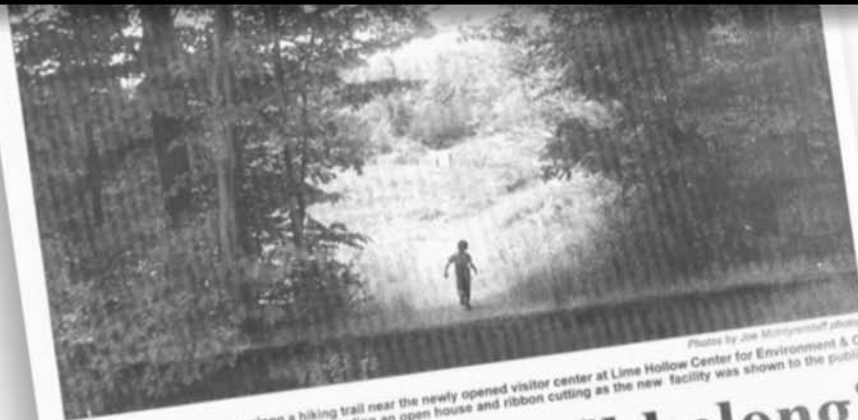

'It's where we all belong'

Lime Hollow unveils new visitor center and trail on Saturday

CORTLANDVILLE — A steady crowd streamed into the new visitor center at Lime Hollow Center for Environment & Culture on Saturday to celebrate its opening.

John Hoeschle, president of the center's board of directors, told an audience of at least 75 people that hundreds of volunteer hours, from carpentry to getting displays ready, went into the making of the new visitor center.

"Three-hundred thousand dollars worth of volunteer work went into this place," he said.

Later, Glenn Reissweber, executive director of the center, said a three-year building campaign raised \$782,000 for the expansion. He said the entire project — visitor center and trail development — would have cost around \$1 million had it not been for volunteers. He said, for example, all the electrical
